There will be an emphasis throughout on clear communication of objectives and manouvres with daily brief and debrief so everyone can learn as much as possible. Those wishing to get some extra miles for their RYA qualifications may like to do the delivery trips.

Places are limited as we run the one boat only.

There will be other opportunities to race practice on Anticipation at no charge for Cork crew including Tuesday evenings in Cowes and possibly the Warsash Big Boat series.

So why a 40.7 and why Anticipation?

Simply put, the 40.7 fleet provides some of the best class racing available with almost 50 boats competing in South Coast events.

Notwithstanding being the newly crowned National Champion of 2007, Anticipation has consistently performed well in 40.7 racing and has regularly been in the top 3 at prestige events such as Round the Island, Cowes Week and Little Britain.

There are many charter businesses offering you a ride for Cork Week. But few if any will feature a multiple world champion and olympian as your professional skipper. Also many skippers do not own their own boat.

So Anticipation will be presented with race winning sails and tuning notes, clean hull, proven race winning skipper and a combination of racing intensity and clear explanations of 'why' combined with a relaxed and enjoyable approach to the racing and socialising.

Anticipation is also uniquely rated to provide a choice of utilising bowsprit and asymmetric spinnakers and code zero, staysails and jib top in addition to the conventional fractional and masthead spinnakers. So we can have plenty of fun afloat as well as ashore!
